Funding

- Funding typically ranges from \$1,000 to \$50,000 with the amount depending on the number of Horizon Power service areas your initiative includes
- Co-investment (cash or in-kind) is encouraged, particularly for larger requests
- Horizon Power may act as a first funder where support enables additional investment

Focus areas

We're looking to support initiatives that align with one or more of our focus areas. This includes initiatives that build participation, capability and resilience across education, culture, creativity, community life and local opportunity.

Better community spaces

Improve comfort, affordability and usability of shared spaces plus helping facilities work better for the people who rely on them.

Examples:

- ✓ Upgrading community halls or shared spaces including rooftop solar and/or battery.
- ✓ Energy efficiency upgrades like insulation or appliances.

Better everyday decision making

Build understanding and confidence so people can make informed everyday decisions about costs, comfort and resource use. This could include programs that build skills, knowledge to increase decision making and make positive behaviour changes to improve lifestyle choices.

Examples:

- ✓ A workshop that informs and educates women in managing personal finances to build confidence.
- ✓ A program that is culturally informed to build community awareness.
- ✓ Programs targeted at care givers about child safety messages.
- ✓ Programs that use arts and creative expression to convey a positive message and grow awareness.

Staying connected during extreme weather and emergency events

Support communities to stay safe, connected and functioning during disruption and extreme conditions.

Examples:

- ✓ Purchasing equipment that is critical for reliable, safe and effective response during an emergency such as telecommunication equipment or generator.
- ✓ Age-appropriate education programs on recognising and responding to heat stress.

Stronger future pathways for youth and communities

Develop local skills, leadership and opportunities that support long-term thriving communities.

Examples:

- ✓ Programs to encourage school attendance and build engagement and confidence through the school years.
- ✓ Programs that support the development of positive role models and future leaders.
